

Eminent Leadership Scholar Award 2021

Sponsored by Elsevier and the University of Mississippi

We invite nominations for the 2021 Network of Leadership Scholars (NLS) Eminent Leadership Scholar Award. Nominations are due **March 30, 2021**.

Each year, NLS honors a scholar with the Eminent Leadership Scholar Award. This award recognizes a senior scholar whose work best reflects the mission of NLS to advance interdisciplinary dialogue and discussion regarding the study and practice of leadership. This award is sponsored by Elsevier and includes a USD\$500 honorarium.

Eligibility

- The nominee must have completed his or her PhD (or finished his or her training/education) at least **20 years ago**.
- The nominee should have an outstanding body of work that has made a substantial and original contribution to the field of leadership studies
- The nominee should have contributed to the discipline in ways that complement his or her scholarship (e.g., editorial board service, service as an elected representative for the Academy or other professional organizations, mentoring of outstanding students in the field).
- Eminent Leadership Scholar Award committee members and previous winners of this award are not eligible.

Application Process

- Self-nominations are <u>not</u> accepted.
- A **1 page single spaced letter** describing the nominee's career evolution providing a strong case for his/her contribution to the leadership field. This can include some of the following points:
 - o Number of years since receiving the PhD (must be at least 20 years).
 - o Important and novel research questions in the area of leadership addressed.
 - o Integrated leadership-related career progression.
 - o Leadership-related publications in top-tier journals.
 - o Overall citations and other indices of research productivity.
 - o Publications with students.
 - o Service to the field (e.g., editorial board memberships, conference leadership positions).
 - o Teaching accomplishments in the area of leadership.
 - o Work addressing the research-practice gap.
- The nominee's curriculum vita.
