

Visiting Faculty Position in Psychology at Illinois Institute of Technology.

The Department of Psychology is seeking a visiting Assistant Professor for a one-year appointment to begin Fall 2021. Area of specialization is open, with preference for expertise in industrial and organizational psychology. Candidates should possess a doctoral degree in psychology or a related field (advanced ABD candidates will also be considered). The position will involve teaching three courses per semester (fall and spring), including undergraduate courses such as introductory psychology and industrial-organizational psychology, as well as additional undergraduate or graduate courses depending the candidate's area of specialization.

The Department of Psychology offers undergraduate degrees in Psychological Science, Behavioral Health and Wellness, and Applied Analytics, as well as three scientist-practitioner graduate programs, in Clinical Psychology, I-O Psychology, and Rehabilitation and Mental Health Counseling. Faculty and students work in a collaborative atmosphere both within and between programs. The Center for Research and Service, which is an on-site consulting center supports training, funding, and research efforts of students and faculty and draws on our close affiliations with business partners within the city and suburbs.
