The Department of Management at Marquette University invites applications for a full-time, tenure-track Assistant Professor position in Human Resource Management for the Fall of 2019. Candidates should have a Ph.D., or be close to completing one, in Human Resource Management or a related discipline. An ideal candidate will have demonstrated potential for publication in high-quality journals and have a strong commitment to teaching. Candidates with secondary expertise in Organizational Development are especially encouraged to apply.
