Appointees will hold the title of Visiting Assistant, Clinical Assistant, Clinical Associate, Clinical Professor or Lecturer of Management depending on qualifications and experience.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

The Clinical Professor/Lecturer will be expected to teach at the graduate and undergraduate level depending on needs and qualifications. In addition to teaching the appointee will perform service duties in the Department of Management to assist curriculum development and student success in the College of Business. The Visiting/Temporary Professor will be expected to teach at the undergraduate level.

Preferred candidates will have their PhD in management, strategic management, human resources, organizational behavior or a related field. Preferred candidates will have teaching experience.
